

SUMMARY JURISDICTION.
PETTY SESSIONS DISTRICTS AND
TIMES.

Order, dated 17th September, 1940, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (N.I.), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs, as follows:—

As and from the 28th day of September, 1940,

1. The townlands set forth in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order constituting the Petty Sessions District as set out in Column 1 of the said Schedule shall be added to the Petty Sessions Districts set out in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

2. The Petty Sessions District named in Column 1 of the Schedule shall be abolished.

HILLSBOROUGH RURAL DISTRICT.
PUBLIC HEALTH (IRELAND) ACTS.

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878, the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1896, the Local Government (Ireland) Act, 1898, and of every other power enabling the Ministry in that behalf, has made an Order on the 3rd day of September, 1940, investing the Hillsborough Rural District Council with the powers of an urban sanitary authority

under Section 76 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878 (in regard to the provision of fire appliances) in the Rural District of Hillsborough, and determining that portion of the Townland of Hillsborough comprising the Town of Hillsborough as the area of charge upon which all expenses incurred by the said Council in carrying out the provisions of Section 76 of the said Public Health (Ireland) Act, 1878, shall be chargeable.
