PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES.

The Wholesale Mantle and Costume Trade Board (Northern Ireland) hereby give notice that they propose to vary minimum rates of wages for male and female workers.

The Trade Board will consider any objections to their proposals which may be lodged with them within fourteen days from the 10th April, 1942.
