TAKE Notice, that unless cause is shown to the contrary within two months from this date, the Land Purchase Commission, Northern Ireland, intends to make an order vesting the Estate and Lands referred to in the Schedule

hereunto annexed in the said Land Purchase Commission. The said order will have the effect of vesting the said Estate and Lands in the said Land Purchase Commission, in fee-simple, subject as follows:—

- To any public right affecting the lands.
- To any maintenance charge under the Public Works Acts.
- To any interests of the Tenants on the lands, or of persons having claims upon those interests, and to any easements, rights, and appurtenances mentioned in Section 34 of the Land Law (Ireland) Act, 1896.

but save as aforesaid discharged from the claims of all persons interested in the lands, which claims shall from the date of such Vesting Order cease as against the lands, and attach to the Purchase Money thereof in like manner as immediately before the date of the Order they attached to the lands.
