**TRADE BOARDS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 and 1939.**  
**BRUSH AND BROOM TRADE BOARD (NORTHERN IRELAND).**

The Trade Board established by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland under powers conferred by the Trade Boards Acts (Northern Ireland), 1923 and 1939, for the Brush and Broom Trade in Northern Ireland, hereby give notice that they have received notification, dated the 30th November, 1942, that the Ministry of Labour has made an Order confirming minimum rates of wages as varied by the Trade Board as aforesaid and specifying the seventh day of December, 1942, as the date from which they shall become effective.

On request to the Trade Board particulars of the minimum rates of wages above referred to and information as to their application will be given if, in the opinion of the Trade Board, the applicant is likely to be affected thereby.
