DRESSMAKING AND WOMEN'S LIGHT CLOTHING TRADE BOARD (NORTHERN IRELAND).

PROPOSAL TO FIX AND TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES.

The Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Trade Board (Northern Ireland) hereby give notice that they propose to fix and to vary minimum rates of wages for certain female workers.

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Trade Board at the address given below.

The Trade Board will consider any objections to their proposals which may be lodged with them within one calendar month from the 18th December, 1944, in respect of their proposal to fix a minimum rate and within fourteen days from the 18th December, 1944, in respect of their proposal, to vary a minimum rate.

Any such objection should be in writing, signed by the person making the same (adding his or her address) and sent to the Secretary of the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Trade Board (Northern Ireland), Tyrone House, Ormeau Avenue, Belfast. It is desirable that persons

making objections should state the precise grounds of their objections.
