WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945.

BRUSH AND BROOM WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND).

The Brush and Broom Wages Council (Northern Ireland) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance proposals (1) for the revocation of the Order N.I.B.B. (49), dated 25th November, 1942, and the amendment of the Order N.I.B.B. (47) dated 10th February, 1940, and for the fixing of statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for the minimum rates of wages at present in operation, and (2) for the amendment of the Order N.I.B.B. (45) dated 9th September, 1939, which deals with holidays with pay.

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained from the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within twenty-one days from 1st August, 1946. Any such representations should be signed by the person making the same (adding his or her address) and sent to the Secretary, Brush and Broom Wages Council (Northern Ireland), Tyrone House, Ormeau Avenue, Belfast. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise grounds of their objections.

WHOLESALE MANTLE AND COSTUME WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND).
