STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS OF NORTHERN IRELAND. 1946 No. 119.

Elections: Postponement of publication of Register in respect of the County of Londonderry.

Order, dated 7th August, 1946, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under Section Fourteen of the Elections and Franchise Act (Northern Ireland), 1946.

WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section (3) of Section Thirty of the Elections and Franchise Act (Northern Ireland), 1946 (hereinafter called "the Act of 1946") that the Register of Electors in respect of each administrative county and of the County Borough of Belfast shall be published and come into force on the First day of July, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-six:

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland (hereinfter called "the Ministry") made an Order under the provisions of Section Fourteen of the Act of 1946 entitled the Electoral Register (Postponement of Publication) Order, 1946, postponing the publication of the said Registers until the Fifteenth day of August, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-six:

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Ministry that as respects the Administrative County of Londonderry, the time allowed for the publication of the Register is insufficient and that it should be further postponed:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section Fourteen of the Act of 1946, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling, the Ministry DOETH HEREBY ORDER that the date of publication of the Register for the Administrative County of Londonderry be postponed from the said Fifteenth day of August, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-six, until the Eleventh day of September, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-six.

This Order may be cited as the County of Londonderry Electoral Register (Postponement of Publication) Order (Northern Ireland), 1946.

Johnston, M.B., B.Ch., D.P.H., to hold a Local Inquiry into the matter of the said application commencing at 10 a.m., on Monday, 23rd September, 1946, at the Offices of the Rural District Council, Londonderry, County Londonderry.

Any ratepayer in the said Rural District or other person interested in the matter may attend at the time and place aforesaid and give evidence on the subject of the said application.
