To the Council of the administrative County of
Fermanagh;

To the Council of the Rural District of Enniskillen;

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Enniskillen
Union; and

To all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Council of the Urban District of
Enniskillen on the 3rd October, 1945, submitted pro-
posals to the Council of the administrative County
of Fermanagh (in this Order referred to as "the
County Council") for the alteration of the boundary
of the said urban district.

AND WHEREAS the County Council, in exercise
of the powers conferred upon them by section
twenty-four of the Local Government Act (North-
ern Ireland), 1934, and of all other powers thereunto
them enabling, at a quarterly meeting held on the
19th day of July, 1946, made an order giving effect
to the said proposal with modifications.

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Health and
Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this
Order referred to as "the Ministry") on the 16th
day of January, 1947, duly confirmed the Order
made by the County Council.

AND WHEREAS the Rural District of Ennis-
killen situate in the administrative County of Fer-
managh is now divided into twenty-six district
electoral divisions named respectively the Aghan-
aglack, Ballycassidy, Ballyrcagh, Castlecoole, Clabby,
Coolymermer, Corraglass, Derrybrusk, Doagh, Dru-
mane, Drumderg, Drummeec, Enniskillen Rural,

Florence Court, Garvary, Holywell, Killesher, Kin-
awley, Kinglass, Lisbellaw, Lisbofin, Monea, New-
porton, Old Barr, Rahalton, Tempo.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the con-
stitution of the District Electoral Division of Ennis-
killen Rural should be altered in the manner
hereinafter appearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry in exercise
of its powers under the Poor Relief Acts (Northern
Ireland), 1838 to 1937, the Local Government Acts
(Northern Ireland), 1898 to 1946 and of all other
powers in that behalf enabling the Ministry, hereby
orders and directs that:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in any
Order to the contrary the district electoral
division of Enniskillen Rural in the said Rural
District shall consist of the townlands, parts of
townlands and places set forth by name in
Column 2 of the Schedule to this Order oppo-
site to the name of such district electoral division.

And it is hereby declared that the foregoing
provisions of this Order shall in no way affect
or be deemed to affect the limits of any area
heretofore determined by any Order to be the
area of charge upon which any special expenses
as defined by Section 232 of the Public Health
(Ireland) Act, 1878, or any other expenses di-
rected by any Act to be defrayed as such special
expenses are and shall be chargeable.
