The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under Section 9 of the Finance Act, 1933, and Section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, viz:—

The Silk Duties (Termination of Excise Drawback) Order, 1950, which terminates with effect from the 1st June, 1950, the excise drawbacks on artificial silk allowable under Section 5 of the Finance Act, 1925, consequent upon the repeal (by the Finance Act, 1947) of the excise duties chargeable under that section.

The Order also effects a measure of consolidation of the law relating to customs drawbacks allowable under Section 4 of the 1925 Act.
