

queathed amongst other legacies the following Charitable Bequests:—

One hundred pounds to the Trustees for the time being of First Cookstown Presbyterian Church, to be applied by them for such Charitable purposes in connection with the said Church as they shall think fit;

The residue of his estate (after payment of his debts, funeral, and testamentary expenses and pecuniary legacies and the making over of specific bequests) in equal shares to Doctor Barnardo's Homes, National Incorporated Association, of 18/26 Stepney Causeway, London, E.1; The British Sailors' Society of 680 Com-

mercial Road, London, E.14; and the Ulster Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

Probate of the said Will (with said two Codicils) was on the 28th day of May, 1952, granted forth of the Principal Probate Registry of the High Court of Justice in Northern Ireland to Belfast Bank Executor and Trustee Company, Limited, of 13 Donegall Square North, Belfast, the sole Executor therein named.
