WAGES COUNCILS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945

READYMADE AND WHOLESALE BESPOKE TAILORING WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND)

The Readymade and Wholesale Bespoke Tailoring Wages Council (Northern Ireland) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance proposals for fixing statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for that fixed by the current Wages Regulation Orders relating to workers in respect of whom the Wages Council operates.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within twenty-one days from 23rd February, 1962. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.

URBAN DRAINAGE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1957

Order confirming a Draft Urban Drainage Scheme for the improvement of drainage in the Carland Road Area, Dungannon.

WHEREAS the Council of the Urban District of Dungannon (hereinafter called "the Council") being duly authorised in that behalf by the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (hereinafter called "the Ministry"), prepared a draft urban drainage scheme (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme"), pursuant to the provisions of the above mentioned Act for the improvement of drainage in the Carland Road Area.

And Whereas the Scheme was exhibited at the offices of the Council during a period of one month from the 29th November, 1961, and a copy of the Scheme was forwarded to the Ministry of Commerce as required by sub-section (1)(a) of Section four of the said Act.

And Whereas pursuant to the provisions of sub-section (1)(b) of Section four of the said Act a notice stating that the scheme had been prepared and further stating as by the said Act required was duly published in one newspaper on the 30th November, 1961, in another on the 2nd December, 1961, and in the Belfast Gazette on the 1st December, 1961.

And Whereas no observations in regard to the Scheme have been received by the Council or the Ministry.

Now Therefore the Ministry in exercise of the power contained in sub-section (1) of Section five of the said Act by this Order confirms the Scheme.
