THE IMPORTED LIVESTOCK ORDER, 1958

I, William J. Patterson, being an authorised officer for the purpose of the Imported Livestock Order, 1958, hereby give notice that on the 21st day of April, 1966, at or in the vicinity of Donaghmore, Dungannon, Co. Tyrone, the undermentioned One livestock was seized in accordance with the provisions of the said Order.
