ULSTER SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

Sixth Issue

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Diseases of Animals Acts (Northern Ireland) 1958 and 1966 made on 10th July, 1967, a Scheme entitled "Warble Fly (Eradication) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967", which empowers the Ministry to dress all cattle born before 1st August, 1967, with a systemic insecticide for the purpose of controlling Warble Fly infestation with a view to the eventual elimination of this insect pest.

The Scheme came into operation on 15th August, 1967, and shall remain in operation until 31st July, 1968.
