FLOUR PRICES

AGRICULTURAL RETURNS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1939 AS AMENDED BY AGRICULTURE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965
