Republic of Ireland: Official Certificate

The Ministry of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 it hereby recognises the Official Certificate of the design shown in Part I of the Schedule hereto for the importation into Northern Ireland from the Republic of Ireland of meat of a description given in Part II of the Schedule as showing (i) that the meat to which it relates was derived from mammals inspected before and after death and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Ministry, and (ii) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the meat was carried out with all the preparation of the meat was carried out with all the necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

The Official Certificate being in the form of a stamp, recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the meat or the package containing the meat.

- (a) Portions of carcases, with or without bone, comprising recognisable wholesale or retail cuts which contain no associated lymphatic gland or from which has been removed in preparing or trimming the meat, any pleura, peritoneum or lymphatic gland;
- (b) the tongue from any bovine animal from which a submaxillary lymphatic gland has been removed;
- (c) minced or chopped meat other than liver with or without the addition of any spices, cereal products, salt, flavouring, vegetable or other ingredient.

Recognition does not extend to boneless veal appearing to an authorised officer to be from calves less than three months old.

Recognition is extended until 31st May 1969, to include sheep and pig livers from which the lymphatic gland has been removed.
