International Datel 600 Service

The Post Office hereby give notice that a Datel 600 Service, providing for serial transmission of digital data over the public telephone system at speeds of up to 600 binary digits (bits) per second (up to 1200 bits per second on some connexions) will become available from the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man to Australia on 17th November 1969.

The charges on and from 17th November 1969 for Datel 600 calls made from the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man to Australia

are shown below. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with regulation 25 of the Telephone Regulations 1968 and regulation 6 of the Telephone (Channel Islands) Regulations 1968 (in force as schemes under the Post Office Act 1969) and may be revised at any time by the Post Office.

The Post Office hereby gives notice in accordance with Regulation 21 of the Telephone Regulations 1968 in force as schemes under the Post Office Act 1969 that, until further notice, the charges for telephone calls from the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man to the country mentioned in Column 1 of the said Schedule (hereto provided) shall be those set out in the said Schedule.
