H.M. TREASURY

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under Sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act, 1958, and Section 2(5) of the Finance Act, 1965.

Viz.: The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 2) Order, 1970.

This Order revises the rates of drawback of import duty in respect of certain specified linseed oil and linseed oil goods manufactured from imported linseed or linseed oil.

This Order comes into operation on 5th March, 1970, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1970 No. 270.

Viz.: The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 1) Order, 1970.

This Order provides that the goods listed in Schedule 1 shall be temporarily exempt from import duty, and those listed in Schedule 2 shall continue to be exempt from import duty, both until 1st January 1971, except for items for which an earlier day is specified.

The Order comes into operation on 5th March, 1970, and has been published as Statutory Instrument 1969 No. 269.

PAY OF THE ARMED FORCES

On 2nd November, 1967, in pursuance of their

powers under section 3(2) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the Secretary of State for Economic Affairs, the Chancellor of the Exchequer and the Secretary of State for Defence instructed the National Board for Prices and Incomes to keep under continuous review the pay and allowances of members of naval, military or air forces of the Crown and of any women's service administered by the Defence Council. The Board has now made its Third report, and in accordance with section 5(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, the Minister for the Civil Service, the Chancellor of the Exchequer and the Secretary of State for Defence hereby give notice that this report was first published as Command Paper Number 4291 on 25th February, 1970.

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS OF NORTHERN IRELAND 1970 No. 17

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture with the approval of the Minister of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957 made on the 20th January 1970 the Cattle Headage Payments Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970, No. 17.

This Scheme provides that payments may be made in respect of home-bred cattle certified in Northern Ireland under the Fatstock Guarantee Scheme in the
