SCHEME T1/1970

Note.—The Scheme which follows this note amends the Telephone Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 1256) (which have effect under paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 9 to the Post Office Act 1969 as if they were provisions of a scheme made under section 28 of that Act).

The amending Scheme increases the maximum amounts of certain charges for connecting, removing or changing equipment or apparatus. This Note is not part of the Scheme.

The Post Office (Telephone) Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1970

Made	3 April, 1970
Coming into Operation	13 April 1970

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Section 28 of and paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 9 to the Post Office Act 1969 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

- (1) This Scheme shall come into operation on the thirteenth day of April, 1970, and may be cited as the Post Office (Telephone) Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1970.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Telephone Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 1256) (hereinafter called "the Regulations").
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Connection charges

- In Schedule 5 of the Regulations for item 1 there shall be substituted the following item:
