JURY LAWS AMENDMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926.

WHEREAS it is provided by section eighteen of the Jury Laws Amendment Act (Northern Ireland), 1926 (in this Order referred to as "the Act") that the Governor of Northern Ireland may, by Order in Council, alter, in connection with the first jurors books to be brought into use under the provisions of the Act, any dates fixed by the Juries Acts for the purposes of the preparation and revision of the lists from which the jurors books are to be prepared :

And whereas it is expedient to alter, in connection with the jurors books to be brought into use for the county of the city consisting of the county borough of Belfast next after the first day of January, 1927 (being the first jurors books to be brought into use therefor under the provisions of the Act), certain dates fixed as aforesaid :

NOW WE, the Lords Justices for the government of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, in exercise of all powers hereunto enabling Us, do hereby order as follows :—

In connection with the jurors books to be brought into use for the said county of a city next after the first day of January, 1927—

(a) the first day of September, 1926, shall be substituted for the first day of August, 1926, as the date on or before which the general

list of jurors prepared by the town clerk of the said county borough is to be delivered to the clerk of the crown and peace of the said county of a city ;

(b) the fifteenth day of September, 1926, shall be substituted for the fifteenth day of August, 1926, as the date on or before which the clerk of the crown and peace of the said county of a city is to cause the list of special jurors to be made out.
