NORTHERN IRELAND LAND ACT, 1925. NORTHERN IRELAND LAND (FINANCE) RULES.

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, after the expiration of at least forty days from the date of publication of this notice, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by Section 7 and other sections of the Northern Ireland Land Act, 1925, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, to make Rules and Regulations under the last-mentioned Act.

CIVIL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL POWERS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922.

I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, Do Hereby delegate unconditionally to the following Police Officer, namely, Frederick Ambrose Britten, Esquire, Deputy Inspector-General, Royal Ulster Constabulary, all the powers vested in me as Civil Authority under Regulation 23 of the Regulations made under the said Statute, to exercise concurrently with

me and with any other person or persons to whom a similar delegation may have been or may hereafter be made the said powers throughout the whole of Northern Ireland, such delegation to continue until revoked, and the said Police Officer shall for the purpose of the said Regulation be concurrently with me and such other person or persons the Civil Authority for the whole of Northern Ireland.
