## THE CLEAN AIR ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964

### CASTLEREAGH RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Castlereagh Number 5 Smoke Control Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1971

1. Notice is hereby given that the Castlereagh Rural District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 27th May, 1971, made an Order entitled the Castlereagh No. 5 Smoke Control Order (Northern Ireland) 1971, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Ministry of Health and Social Services for confirmation.

2. By virtue of Section 11 of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas, and electricity. Paper and sticks, although not authorised fuels, may be used for kindling purposes.

3. Copies of the Order and the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, 368 Cregagh Road, Belfast, BT6 9EZ, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 9th June, 1971.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by Notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Health and Social Services, Dundonald House, Belfast, BT4 3SF, object to the confirmation of the Order.
