(Scheme 1): that part of the Blacker Burn Extension flowing through or between the townlands of Knock, Hacknahay, Drumlisnagrilly, Drumnacanny, Ballynaghy, Knocknamuckly, Ballygargan, Ballymacrandal, Ballydugan and Ballynagarrick in the County of Armagh;

(Scheme 2): that part of the Ballymacrandal Drain flowing through or between the townlands of Ballymacrandal, Ballynaghy, Ballygargan and Ballyhannon in the County of Armagh;

(Scheme 3): that part of the Drumnacanny Drain flowing through or between the townlands of Drumnacanny, Drumlisnagrilly and Breagh in the County of Armagh;

which the Drainage Council have determined to be minor watercourses within the meaning of Section 2(1) of the Drainage Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.
