ROADS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948

The Ministry of Development hereby gives notice that it has been requested by Antrim County Council to make an Order under Section 17 of the Roads Act (Northern Ireland) 1948, the effect of which would be to authorise the abandonment of two lengths totalling approximately 264 metres (289 linear yards) of Route No. A26, Moira to Nutt's Corner Road, in the townlands of Loughrelish and Brackenhill.

PLANNING (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1972

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Development, on behalf of the Secretary of State, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Articles 11(2)(e) and 106 of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 made an Order on 1st August, 1973, entitled the Planning (Use Classes) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 (S.R.&O. 1973, No. 263).

This Order comes into force on 1st October, 1973, and specifies use classes for the purpose of Article 11(2)(e) of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1972. By virtue of the said Article 11, the use of buildings or other land for any other purpose of the same class shall not be taken to involve development of land for which planning permission would be required.

deal with the making of claims for compensation arising from the application of listed building control and the serving of listed building purchase notices. Forms of notices are prescribed for notifying the owner and occupier of a building when it has become listed, or has ceased to be listed.
