FIRE SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969

The Ministry of Home Affairs gives notice that it has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Fire Services (Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 (Statutory Rule and Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 No. 251).

Australia: Official Certificate
