

Republic of Ireland: Official Certificate

The Department of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 it hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 27th April, 1973, for the importation of meat and meat products into Northern Ireland from the Republic of Ireland to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 26th April, 1974, is hereby revoked.
