Note—The following diseases have not appeared in Northern Ireland since the year shown after each disease: Sheep Pox (*Variola Ovis*), 1850; Rinderpest (*pestis Bovina*), 1877; Pleuro-Pneumonia (*Peripneumonia, Contagiosa Bovum*), 1893; Glanders (including Farcy) (*Malleus*), 1913; Rabies (*rage*), 1923; Foot and Mouth Disease (*Pieve Aphteuse*), 1941; Parasitic Mange (*Sarcopies Scabei Equi*), 1946; and Swine Fever (*Peste Porcine*), 1958.

Epizootic Lymphangitis (*Lymphangitis Epizootica*), Dourine and Fowl Plague have never existed in Northern Ireland.

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
