A PROCLAMATION  
FURTHER PROROGUING THE PRESENT  
PARLIAMENT OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, that the Lord Lieutenant shall, in His Majesty's name, summon, prorogue and dissolve the Parliament of Northern Ireland;

And Whereas the Parliament of Northern Ireland stands prorogued to Tuesday, the 21st day of February next:

NOW, I, The Right Honourable Edmund Bernard, Viscount FitzAlan of Derwent, Lieutenant-General and General Governor of Ireland, by and with the advice of the Executive Committee of Northern Ireland, by this Proclamation do publish and declare His Majesty's Pleasure that the said Parliament be further prorogued to Tuesday, the 14th day of March next;

And I do hereby further, with the advice aforesaid, declare His Majesty's Royal Will and Pleasure to be that the said Parliament shall on the said Tuesday, the 14th day of March next, assemble and be holden for the despatch of divers urgent and important affairs, and the Senators and Members of the House of Commons of Northern Ireland are hereby required to give their attendance accordingly.

SAFEGUARDING OF INDUSTRIES.

PREVENTION OF DUMPING.

RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR COMMITTEES UNDER PART II OF THE SAFEGUARDING OF INDUSTRIES ACT, 1921, (11 & 12 GEO. 5, c. 47), DATED FEBRUARY 6, 1922, PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD OF TRADE IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 7 (3) OF THE SAID ACT.

1. The Rules of Procedure for Committees under Part II of the Safeguarding of Industries Act, 1921, dated September, 23rd 1921 (S.R.O., 1921, No. 1514), prescribed by the Board of Trade in pursuance of Section 7 (3) of the said Act, are hereby revoked.

2. If the Board of Trade decide to refer any matter under Section 2 of the Safeguarding of Industries Act, 1921, to a Committee constituted in accordance with Section 7 of the Act, the Board will as soon as may be after the appointment of the Committee publish in the London, Edinburgh, Dublin and Belfast Gazettes, or in such other manner as the Board think proper, a notice stating—

- (a) the terms of reference to the Committee;
- (b) the time and place at which the Committee propose to hold their first sitting for the taking of evidence, which shall not be less than fourteen days after the date on which publication of the notice is completed.

3. The Board of Trade will appoint a Chairman of the Committee, who shall preside at any meeting of the Committee.
