The Attorney-General for Northern Ireland has appointed Messrs. J. C. Davison, K.C., M.P., and B. Maginess, B.L., to be Prosecuting Counsel for the Crown at the forthcoming Northern Ireland Winter Assizes, to be held at Belfast, commencing on 7th December, 1927, at 11-30 a.m.

The Civil Service Commission for Northern Ireland hereby give notice that the following regulations are published with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, viz.:—

REGULATIONS RESPECTING OPEN COMPETITIONS FOR THE SITUATION OF TYPIST IN THE CIVIL SERVICE.

1. The limits of age are 18 and 28. A candidate must have attained the lower age and must not have attained the higher age on or before the governing date. The governing date is the 31st March where the competition commences in the first six months of the year, and the 30th September where it commences in the second six months of the year. A candidate may, however, deduct from her age, for the purpose of bringing it within the prescribed limits, any time not exceeding two years which she has spent in an established situation in the Civil Service of Northern Ireland.

- 2. A candidate must be a natural-born British subject, and the daughter of a father who is a natural-born British subject.
- 3. A candidate must be unmarried or a widow, and must satisfy the Commissioners, in such manner as they may require, of her fitness for appointment in respect of health and character.
- 4. A person on whose training for the occupation of teacher public money has been spent, cannot be appointed until the consent of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland has been notified to the Commissioners.
- A person holding a situation in the Civil Service of Northern Ireland must obtain the permission of the authorities of the department in which she is serving to enter the competition before presenting herself thereat.

No candidate will be regarded as qualified who does not pass to the satisfaction of the Commissioners in English and Typewriting.

The Commissioners may, at their discretion, restrict admission to Part II. of the competition to such number of candidates qualified in English, and at the head of a list based on the aggregates of the marks awarded for the four subjects comprised in Part I., as they may think fit Similarly, they may restrict admission to Part III. of the competition to such number of candidates qualified in English and Typewriting, at the head of a list based on the aggregates of the marks awarded for Parts I. and II., as they may think fit.

The final placing of candidates admitted to Part III., who qualify in English and Typewriting, will be determined by the aggregates of the marks awarded in the three parts of the competition.

The examination in the subjects included in Parts I. and II. and the Interview forming Part III. of the competition, will be held at such times and in such places as the Commissioners may appoint.

- 6. A successful candidate may be assigned to any Department of the Government of Northern Ireland in accordance with the interests of the public service.
- 7. An application for permission to attend an Examination must be made in such manner and at such times as may be prescribed by the Commissioners in the notice thereof, and must be accompanied by a fee of seven shillings and sixpence.

ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Commissioners further give notice that an open Competition under the foregoing Regulations will be held in Belfast, commencing on the 14th February, 1928.

It is anticipated that the maximum number of appointments to be made as the result of the Competition will be ten.

No person will be admitted to the Competition from whom the Secretary to the Civil Service Commission has not received, on or before the 7th January, 1928, an application in the candidate's own handwriting on a prescribed form, bearing Civil Service stamps (overprinted Northern Ireland) to the amount of the fee laid down in the Regulations. A copy of the prescribed form and of the syllabus, together with information as to the appointments, can be obtained by prospective candidates on application to the Secretary to the Commission.
