ABERCORN.

WHEREAS by Section 1 of the Resident Magistrates (Ireland) Act, 1920, it is provided that the Lord Lieutenant may, by Order made with the concurrence of the Treasury prescribe the rates and scales of salaries and allowances to be paid to resident magistrates and the conditions applicable thereto, and, subject to the provisions of the Order, any rates, scales and conditions thereby prescribed shall have effect as from the date therein specified instead of the rates, scales and conditions prescribed by or in pursuance of the Resident Magistrates and Police Commissioners Salaries Act, 1874, or any other Act, or by any previous Order under this section or otherwise:

AND WHEREAS by an Order dated the 12th day of July, 1923, the rates and scales of salaries and allowances to be paid to resident magistrates and the conditions applicable thereto were duly prescribed:

AND WHEREAS by the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, the Orders and Regulations made thereunder and the Irish Free State (Consequential Provisions) Act, 1922, references to the Lord Lieutenant in their application to Northern Ireland are to be construed as references to the Governor of Northern Ireland, and references to the Treasury in their application to Northern Ireland are to be construed as references to the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland:

NOW, I, JAMES ALBERT EDWARD, DUKE OF ABERCORN, Governor of Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the said Act and of all

other powers me thereunto enabling with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, Do Hereby Order and Prescribe that the following shall be the rates and scales of salaries and allowances to be paid to resident magistrates and the conditions applicable thereto:—

(1) A scale salary rising from £550 a year by annual increments of £20 to £690 a year, and then by annual increments of £25 to £900 a year, with effect as from the first day of April, 1923, or from the date of commencement of service, if later.

(2) Allowances in respect of travelling expenses for journeys undertaken on official duty at the rates and subject to the conditions from time to time prescribed by the Ministry of Finance in respect of Civil Servants on a similar scale of salary.

(3) Subsistence allowance at the rates and subject to the conditions from time to time prescribed by the Ministry of Finance in respect of Civil Servants on a similar scale of salary.

(4) An allowance of £8 a year for postage, stationery and incidental expenses.

PROVIDED that a resident magistrate who has been transferred from the Government of the United Kingdom to the Government of Northern Ireland under the provisions of the Constabulary (Ireland) Act, 1922, or who has been appointed by the Government of Northern Ireland, after having previously served as a resident magistrate under the Government of the United Kingdom, shall be entitled as from the 1st April, 1923, or from the date of appointment, if later, to payment of salary at the rate which would have been payable to him if the above scale had been in operation from

the time of his permanent appointment by the Government of the United Kingdom.

PROVIDED also that a resident magistrate who is serving as such at the date of this Order shall be entitled to the payment of an allowance of £100 a year in respect of travelling expenses for journeys undertaken on official duty within a distance of 10 miles from Headquarters, and the allowances in respect of travelling expenses hereinbefore provided for shall not be payable in respect of any such journeys, except journeys by rail undertaken on official duty to destinations which are outside a radius of ten miles from Headquarters.

AND I do hereby order and direct that this Order shall have effect as from the 1st day of April, 1928, and that from and after such date the rates and scales of salaries and allowances and the conditions applicable thereto hereinbefore prescribed shall be substituted for the rates and scales of salaries and allowances and the conditions applicable thereto which were prescribed by the above-mentioned Order, dated the 12th day of July, 1923.

MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

IMPORTED EGGS IN SHELL AND DRIED EGGS.

It is announced that further applications for an Order in Council under the above-mentioned Act, to require the marking of imported eggs in shell and receptacles containing dried eggs, have been referred for inquiry to the Standing Committee set up under the Act by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Secretary of State for the Home Department and the Secretary of State for Scotland, acting jointly.

Attention is called to the fact that, under the provisions of the Act, while the Committee in every case referred to them must consider whether the goods should bear the indication of origin at the time of sale or exposure for sale, they may also, at their discretion, consider and report upon the question whether such goods should bear an indication of origin at the time of importation.

The date of the Enquiry in this case will be announced later. Any communication with regard to the matter should, however, be addressed, as early as possible, to Mr. H. J. Johns, the Secretary of the Standing Committee, 10 Whitehall Place, London, S.W.1

DANGEROUS AND UNHEALTHY INDUSTRIES.

NOTICE is hereby given, in pursuance of Section 86 (1) of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, that on the 15th March, 1928, the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland made Regulations under Section 79 of the said Act to apply to all factories and workshops or parts thereof in which the painting of vehicles with lead paint is carried on. The Regulations, which may be cited as the Vehicle Painting Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1928, come into force on the 1st May, 1928.
