### DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE

The Department of Finance has made an Order entitled Selective Employment Payments (Termination of Payment and Consequential Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 No. 213 which comes into operation on 31st July, 1979, and prescribes that selective employment premiums will cease to be payable in respect of weeks commencing after that date.

The Order also contains supplementary provisions for dealing with claims for payment of premiums in respect of weeks commencing before 31st July, 1979, and with questions which are outstanding at that date arising in connection with payment of premiums.

### AGRICULTURAL RETURNS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1939

The purpose of this Rule is to revoke Regulation 7(2)(b) of the Grammar School Pupils (Admissions, Grants and Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978. That Regulation provided for the inclusion in the grant, calculated by an Education and Library Board under Regulation 7(2) of those Regulations and paid by the Department of Education to the school authorities concerned, of the amount of examination fees of non-fee-paying pupils enrolled in voluntary grammar schools.

From the operative date of these regulations such fees will be paid by Education and Library Boards under Article 45(2) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1972.
