# THE NORTHERN IRELAND (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) (VEHICLE CONTROL ZONE) ORDER 1982

In purusance of regulation 2 of the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Regulations 1978, which are set out in Schedule 3 to the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1978(a), I hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) (Vehicle Control Zone) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 15th March, 1982.
- 2. The Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) (Vehicle

Control Zone) (No. 2) Order 1978(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.

3. The restriction specified in column 2 of Part I of Schedule 6 to the principal Order (which relates to Royal Ulster Constabulary – "G" Division) applying to those roads or areas within the general location of Newtownards described in column 1 shall be amended to read "No vehicle allowed between the hours of 11.00 p.m. and 6.30 a.m.", and in Part II of the said Schedule the restriction specified in column 2 of that Part so applying to the general location of Newtownards described in column 1 of that Part shall be amended to read "No vehicle to be left unattended between the hours of 6.30 a.m. and 11.00 p.m.".
