## EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

In virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the Explosives Act, 1875, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, hereby appoint Sergeant J. V. Lewis (No. 1633), of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, as an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the said Act, and do hereby direct him to exercise only such powers and to perform such duties under the said Act as I shall from time to time assign to him.

WAR LOAN (SUPPLEMENTAL PROVISIONS) ACT, 1915 (5 and 6 Geo. V., c. 93),  
WAR LOAN ACT, 1918 (8 and 9 Geo. V.,  
c. 25) and SAVINGS BANKS ACT, 1929  
(19 and 20 Geo. V., c. 27).

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, they propose, in conjunction with the National Debt Commissioners, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the War Loan (Supplemental Provisions) Act, 1915, the War Loan Act, 1918, and the Savings Bank Act, 1929, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make Regulations entitled the Post Office Register (Trustee Savings Banks) Regulations, 1929.

Under the powers conferred by Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, the Regulations have been brought into force as Provisional Regulations as from the 21st November, 1929.

### EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

ORDER.

CIVIL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL POWERS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922.

WHEREAS by Regulation 26 of the Regulations contained in the Schedule to the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922, it is provided that the Civil Authority may, by notice, prohibit the circulation of any newspaper for any specified period, and that any person circulating or distributing such newspaper within such specified period shall be guilty of an offence against the Regulations in the said Schedule:

And whereas a newspaper, expressed to be printed for the proprietors by the Mellifont Press, Limited, Dublin, and published at 31 Exchequer Street, Dublin, under the title "AN PHOBLACHT"—"THE REPUBLIC" or "THE LOYALIST" or other alias contains treasonable and seditious matter:

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, being the Civil Authority under the said Act, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the said Act and Regulations do hereby prohibit the circulation of the said newspaper entitled "AN PHOBLACHT"—"THE REPUBLIC" or "THE LOYALIST" or under any other title or alias whatever in Northern Ireland from the 1st day of January, 1930, until the 31st day of December, 1930.

RAILWAY RATES TRIBUNAL.  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1929.  
ELEVENTH SCHEDULE.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Railway Rates Tribunal will sit on the 28th day of January, the 8th day of April, the 15th day of July, and the 28th day of October, 1930, to determine any question as to whether any Rebate is or was allowable or as to the basis on which any Rebate should be or should have been calculated under the Railway Freight Rebate Scheme.

The Tribunal have prescribed the following procedure with respect thereto:

1.—All applications for the determination of any of the questions referred to must be filed in the Office of the Registrar to the Tribunal not less than twenty-one days before each of the days appointed for the hearing of the same. Each application must be stamped with an adhesive fee stamp for £1 (which can only be purchased at the office of the Tribunal).

2.—The files containing the applications filed in accordance with the previous paragraph will be open for public inspection at the office of the Registrar at any time during office hours.

3.—In the case of applications by any Railway Company which contain more than one such question for determination each such application shall be printed and copies supplied to persons desiring the same by the Secretary, The Railway Clearing House, Seymour Street, Euston Square, London, N.W.1, at a charge of 2s 6d each, post free.

4.—Any railway company or person or any representative body of traders interested desiring to object to any application must file with the Registrar a notice of such objection stating concisely the ground thereof and must deliver a copy of the same by registered post to the

applicant concerned; such notice to be filed and delivered respectively not less than 7 days before the date appointed for the hearing of the application. In the case of an objection by any representative body of traders the notice shall include a statement of the facts upon which it claims to represent a substantial number of persons interested in the selected traffics concerned.

Each notice filed must be stamped with an adhesive fee stamp for 2s 6d (which can only be purchased at the office of the Tribunal).

5.—Five additional copies of each applica-

tion or objection must be lodged with the original at the office of the Registrar.

6.—The procedure prescribed herein shall not prejudice the right of any railway company or person to bring an application for which a special hearing is desired.
