# DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred by Articles 12 and 14 of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order

1972 has made regulations entitled: The Health and Personal Social Services (Superannuation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1984 (S.R. 1984 No. 336).

The regulations were made on 18th September, 1984 and come into operation on 29th October, 1984. These regulations consolidate, with certain amendments, the provisions of the Health Services (Superannuation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962 to 1983 which provide for the superannuation of persons engaged in the Health and Personal Social Services.

In general, these regulations reproduce the effects of the existing provisions but also contain a number of changes and some improvements to the Health and Personal Social Services Superannuation Scheme.

Some of the main changes and improvements to the scheme include provision for a period of unauthorised unpaid absence to be disregarded for the purpose of assessing an officer's best year of remuneration so that only the last 365 days of paid employment will reckon and the effect of such an absence on the resulting pension will be lessened.

Following a relaxation of Inland Revenue rules governing refunds of contributions, an amendment has been made to remove as from 6th April, 1980, the restriction on a refund of contributions to a person whose salary exceeded £5,000 in any financial year.

The regulations also introduce a revised method of calculating a practitioner's pre-retirement earnings for the purposes of considering any adjustment to his pension on re-employment and the removal of the requirement to modify benefits in accordance with the provisions of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1946 in respect of service on or after 1st April, 1980.
