In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by The Wild Birds' Protection Act, 1894, the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, and the several Statutes and Orders in that behalf, and upon application by the County Council of the County of Down, I hereby make the following Order:—

The taking or destroying of the Eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the Administrative County of Down between the first day of March, 1930, and the first day of August, 1930, and between the first day of March and the first day of August in the four subsequent years:—

Buzzard, Chough, Crossbill, Goldfinch, Harrier (all species), Kingfisher, Peregrine Falcon, Raven, Siskin, Swan, Tern (all species), Gull (all species except the Black-backed Gull), Owl (all species), Kestrel, Pheasant or Green Plover,

and the taking or destroying of the Eggs of all species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the Islands forming part of the said Administrative County between the same dates, during the same period.

FISHING IN LOUGH ERNE.

The Ministry of Finance, as Owner of the Crown rights in the fishing in Lough Erne, hereby gives notice that—

- (1) From and after the date of this Notice, cross-line fishing on Lough Erne is prohibited throughout the entire year. Any person found using a cross-line on any part of the Lough will be liable to prosecution.

- (2) Permits will continue to be required for the use of draft-nets, and in future permits will also be required for the use of long lines for eel fishing. The permits will be obtainable free of charge on application to the Secretary, Ministry of Commerce, Belfast.
- (3) Angling for coarse fish with rod and line will no longer require a permit.
- (4) The charge for permits for trout angling is 2/6 per day, 10/- per fortnight, and £1 for the season, and the obligation on anglers to take out such permits will be strictly enforced. Any person found fishing without a permit will be liable to prosecution. Permits can be obtained from the following Post Offices, viz.:—

**CIVIL SERVICE COMMITTEE FOR

NOTICE OF ELECTION.**

I hereby give notice that in consequence of the resignation of the member of the Civil Service Committee for Northern Ireland appointed by the existing Irish Officers who have been transferred to the Government of Northern Ireland, it is intended to hold an election for the appointment of a member as aforesaid, in accordance with the Treasury Regulations, dated the 22nd December, 1922.

It is provided in the said Treasury Regulations as follows:—

“Every existing Irish Officer within the meaning of the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, who has been transferred to the service of the Government of Northern Ireland under Section 59 of that Act, and is for the time being serving in that service, shall be qualified to vote . . . and is hereinafter referred to as an elector”

No person other than an elector shall be qualified to be a candidate. A nomination paper must be signed by not less than three electors.”

Nomination papers may be obtained on application to me, and must be duly completed and sent to me at the address set forth below, on or before the 10th March, 1930, the cover being marked in the top left hand corner:—“Civil Service Committee—Election.”

If one person only is duly nominated he will be deemed to be elected and a notice to that effect will appear in the Belfast Gazette for the 14th March, 1930.

If more than one person is duly nominated the names of the persons nominated will be published in the Belfast Gazette, and voting papers will be issued to all electors on the 14th day of March, 1930. In that event, all voting papers duly marked and completed in accordance with the directions given thereon must be returned to me at the address given below on or before the 22nd March, 1930; and the result of the poll will be published in the

Belfast Gazette for the 28th March, 1930. Any elector, to whom a voting paper is not issued as aforesaid, is entitled on his or her personal application to me before the day fixed for the return of the voting papers to receive such paper.

TRADE BOARDS ACT

Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Trade Board (Northern Ireland).

The Trade Board established by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland under powers

conferred by the Trade Boards Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, for the Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Trade in Northern Ireland as defined in the Schedule to the Trade Boards (Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Trade, Northern Ireland) (Constitution, Proceedings and Meetings) Regulations, 1925, dated the 20th May, 1925, hereby give notice that they propose to vary and to fix minimum rates of wages for certain classes of female workers in the Factory Branch of the trade.
