MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

WHEREAS Sergeant J. W. Gilmore (1296), of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, was, on the 26th day of April, 1923, appointed to be an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the Explosives Act, 1875:

And whereas the said Sergeant J. W. Gilmore has received an appointment in which he is no longer available for the duties of Inspector:

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the said Act, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do hereby order that the said Sergeant J. W. Gilmore shall from this date cease to exercise the powers and perform the duties of an Inspector under the said Act.

#### EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

In virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the Explosives Act, 1875, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, do hereby appoint Sergeant Owen Gallagher (No. 1285), of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, as an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the said Act, and do hereby direct him to exercise only such powers and to

perform such duties under the said Act as I shall from time to time assign to him.

CIVIL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL POWERS) ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922 and 1928. ORDER.

WHEREAS, by Regulation 26 of the Regulations contained in the Schedule to the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922, it is provided that the Civil Authority may, by notice, prohibit the circulation of any newspaper for any specified period, and that any person circulating or distributing any such newspaper within such specified period shall be guilty of an offence against the Regulations in the said Schedule:

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, being the Civil Authority under the said Act, do hereby prohibit the circulation of the newspaper "The Nation" from the 9th day of March, 1930, until the 8th day of March, 1931.

# MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

# REFERENCE TO STANDING COMMITTEE

In accordance with the provisions of Section 2, sub-Section (4) of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, the Board of Trade give notice that in pursuance of an amended application received by them for the making of an Order in Council to require imported goods of certain classes and descrptions to bear an indication of origin, they have made a reference to the Standing Committee appointed by them under the Act in respect of the following classes and descriptions of imported goods:-

- (a) Drawing boards, sketching boards, easels, T-squares, set-squares, curves, palettes and pantographs ;
- (b) Chalks, crayons and pastels, whether moulded, pressed or cut;

Drawing inks;

- (c) (i) Colours of the types used by artists, art students, architects, draughtsmen and the decorative arts;
  - (ii) Colour boxes, whether filled or unfilled:
- (d) The following articles of the types used by artists and art-students:
  - i) Brushes for oil, water colour and Tempera painting;
  - (ii) Canvas and canvas substitutes, whether mounted on panels or not, and frames and stretchers therefor;
    - (iii) Prepared wood panels.

The reference previously made to the Standing Committee in respect of these classes and descriptions of goods is annulled.

Attention is called to the fact that, while under the provisions of the above Act the Committee must in every case referred to them consider whether the goods should bear an indication of origin at the time of sale or exposure for sale, they may also at their discretion consider and report upon the question whether such goods should bear an indication of origin at the time of importation.

# PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1878-1925.

# BALLYCASTLE RURAL DISTRICT.

And whereas it is expedient that the firstmentioned Order as so amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") should be further amended in manner hereinafter appearing:

And whereas it is necessary on account of the urgency of the matters dealt with by this Order that this Order should come into operation

Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:-

1. The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of paragraph 1 of Schedule VI to the principal Order

"Provided that, where the aircraft has been previously registered in Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Secretary of

State is satisfied—

a) that the certificate of registration last issued in respect of the aircraft lapsed by reason of the sale of the aircraft by the registered owner; and

(b) that the registered owner of the aircraft immediately before the sale was the constructor thereof or a dealer in aircraft;

(c) that the aircraft has not been flown since a certificate of registration was last issued in respect thereof, except for the purpose of-

(i) an experiment or test carried out in the ordinary course of construction or in order to obtain a certificate of airworthiness; or

(ii) a demonstration to a prospective

purchaser; or

(iii) delivering the aircraft to a purchaser;

the fee chargeable for the issue of a certicate shall be five shillings.

2. The following paragraphs shall be substituted for paragraph 6 of Schedule VI to the principal Order:-

"6. Subject to the provisions of this paragraph and paragraph 6s of this Schedule, the fees chargeable in respect of the grant of licences for personnel shall be in accordance with the following table:-

Where an applicant for the grant or renewal of any licence referred to in paragraph 6 of this Schedule is not required to pass any particular part of the appropriate technical examination or official flying test by reason of his having passed that part on some previous application or for any other reason, the fee chargeable for the technical examination or official flying test, as the case may be, may be reduced by such amount as the Secretary of State may think proper in the circumstances of the case.
