**WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE  
CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACTS  
(NORTHERN IRELAND) 1925 AND 1929.**

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland hereby gives notice that regulations have been made under Section 30 (1) of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, as amended by Section 12 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, prescribing the payment of pensions due under those Acts to persons detained in asylums as pauper lunatics to the Local Authorities responsible for their care and maintenance, and the manner in which the Pensions so paid shall be administered.
