The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland hereby give notice that Regulations have been made under Section 30 (1) (e) of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, as amended by Section 19 (2) of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, prescribing the conditions under which contributions in respect of employed persons which were not paid on the due dates but have subsequently been paid or recovered shall be deemed to have been paid on the due dates for the purposes of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts (Northern Ireland), 1925 and 1929.

COLONIAL STOCK ACT, 1900 (63 and 64 Vict., c. 62). Addition to list of Stocks under Section 2.
