The Civil Service Commissioners for Northern Ireland hereby give notice that the following Regulations are published with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, viz.:—

## REGULATIONS RESPECTING LIMITED COMPETITIONS FOR THE SITUATION OF SHORTHAND TYPIST IN THE CIVIL SERVICE OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

1. A candidate must, on or before the commencing date of the competition, have completed to the satisfaction of her Department the prescribed period of probation prior to confirmation of appointment as an established

Typist in the Civil Service, and must on that date actually be serving in that capacity in a Department of the Government of Northern Ireland. A prospective candidate must obtain the permission of the authorities of the Department in which she is serving to enter the competition.

2. A candidate must be unmarried or a widow.

3. A candidate must be a natural born British subject and the daughter of a father who is, or, if deceased, was at the time of his death, a natural born British subject.

4. A successful candidate must satisfy the Commissioners, in such manner as they may require, that she is duly qualified in respect of health, physical fitness and character.

5. The competition will consist of a written examination in:—

Subject.	Marks.
(1) Shorthand	100
(2) English	100
(3) General Paper	50

No candidate will be declared successful who does not pass in Shorthand and secure an adequate percentage of the aggregate marks allotted to the three subjects. The pass mark in Shorthand and the qualifying percentage of the aggregate marks will be determined by the Commissioners.

6. Subject to the fulfilment of the conditions laid down in paragraph 5, the candidates at the head of the list resulting from the total marks awarded to them in the competition will be declared successful, up to such number as may be determined by the Commissioners, and will, if found to be qualified in respect of nationality, health, physical fitness and character, be offered appointments as vacancies arise, whether in the Department in which they are serving or otherwise as the Commissioners may think fit

in the interests of the public service. A candidate who refuses an appointment, for any cause whatsoever, will have no claim to receive any further offer.

7. An application to the Commissioners for permission to sit for the competition must be made in such manner and at such time as may be laid down in the notice of the competition.

The Civil Service Commissioners for Northern Ireland hereby give notice that a competition under the foregoing regulations will be held in Belfast on the 4th March, 1931, for the purpose of filling four vacancies in the grade of Shorthand Typist in Departments of the Civil Service.

No person will be admitted to the competition from whom the Commissioners have not received on or before the 31st January, 1931, an application in the candidate's own handwriting on the prescribed form, which can be obtained, together with a detailed syllabus of the examination and particulars of the appointment, from the Secretary, Civil Service Commission, 15 Donegal Square West, Belfast.

#### MERCHANT SHIPPING. FEES.

NOTES.—(a) Each holding when vested in the purchaser shall continue to have appurtenant thereto, and to be subject to, as the case may be, any previously existing easements, rights and appurtenances.

(b) In case the non-judicial holdings set out in the above List become vested in the Commission under the Act the Standard Purchase Annuities in respect of such holdings shall, as has been done above, be calculated in the manner specified in the Third Schedule to the Act as if the non-judicial Rents were Second Term Judicial Rents, unless an objection is lodged on or before the 9th day of January, 1931.

(c) In the case of Reg. No. 14 the sum set out as rent is the part of the original rent of £41 18s. 0d., payable in respect of the entire holding which has provisionally been apportioned to the portion thereof in the occupation of Alexander Steele, pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 (I) (c) of the Act.
