CREPE BANDAGES AND CREPE BINDERS.

With reference to the notice which was published in the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes of the 7th November, 1930, regarding a reference made by the Board of Trade to the Standing Committee under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, in respect of the following descriptions of imported goods :----

Crepe bandages and crepe binders of all descriptions, made of wool, cotton, silk, artificial silk, or mixtures thereof,
