The Joint Visiting Committee of a Prison appointed at any such time shall continue to act until the specified time for appointment in the next succeeding year, provided always that if any Grand Jury hereby ordered to appoint such members of a Joint Committee shall make default in doing so at the time by this Order appointed for that purpose, the members of the Joint Visiting Committee appointed to represent the Grand Jury making such default as aforesaid shall continue to act until the members of a Joint Visiting Committee shall be appointed at a subsequent time for appointment.

## NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1911 to 1921.

NOTICE is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 2 (2) of the National Health Insurance Act, 1918, to make regulations prescribing the manner in which the total number of married women who are members of approved societies and who are employed contributors is to be calculated in respect of the years 1919 to 1921, both inclusive.
