CONDITIONS ATTACHING TO THIS LICENCE

1. Each consignment must be accompanied by a certificate in accordance with the terms of Council Directive 71/118/EEC as amended, signed by a duly authorised veterinarian of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food stating:

- (i) identification of the meat including species, nature of cuts, number and type of packaging, net weight;
- (ii) address(es) and veterinary approval number(s) of the slaughter house/cutting plants;
- (iii) destination of meat including place of loading, means of transport, place of destination, name and address of consignor, name and address of consignee;
- (iv) *Health attestation*

I, the undersigned, official veterinarian, certify that:

— the poultrymeat described above satisfies the requirements of Directive 91/494/EEC on animal health conditions governing intra-Community trade in and imports from third countries of fresh poultrymeat and also the requirements of the second subparagraph of Article 3A.1 of that Directive.

— the poultrymeat described above/the packaging of the meat described above, bear a mark proving that:

— the meat comes from animals slaughtered in approved slaughterhouses;

— the meat was cut in approved cutting premises;

— the meat has been passed as fit for human consumption following a veterinary inspection carried out in accordance with Council Directive 71/118/EEC of 15th February, 1971 on health problems affecting trade in fresh poultrymeat;

— the transport vehicles or containers and the loading conditions of this consignment meet the hygiene requirements laid down in Directive 71/118/EEC.

2. Any poultrymeat imported in accordance with this licence shall be made available if required for inspection by an Officer of the Department. The importer or his agent shall afford all assistance necessary to such an officer to enable him to carry out the inspection.

NOTES:

Nothing in this licence gives exemption from any prohibition or restriction imposed by the Imported Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991, the Medicines Acts 1968 and 1971 or by any regulation superseding or amending the same.

Any breach of any condition attached to this licence will constitute an offence against the Diseases of Animals (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Department of Agriculture, the Department of Economic Development and the Department of the Environment being Departments designated by the European Communities (Designation) (No. 3) Order 1991 for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to measures relating to informing the public about health protection measures to be taken in the event of a radiological emergency, acting jointly in exercise of the power conferred on them by the said section 2(2) and acting jointly as the Department concerned in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 17(1), (2), and (5) and 55(2) of, and paragraph 12(2) of Schedule 3 to, the Health and Safety at Work (Northern Ireland) Order 1978 and of every other power enabling them in that behalf have made a Statutory Rule entitled the Public

Information for Radiation Emergencies Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1992 (SR 1992 No. 515).

The Regulations:

- (a) place a duty on anyone conducting an undertaking from which a radiation emergency is reasonably foreseeable to inform members of the public actually affected by the radiation and the action to be taken in the event of an emergency;
- (b) place a duty on the Department of Economic Development to prepare and keep up to date arrangements to ensure that members of the public actually affected by the radiation emergency are informed promptly of the facts of the emergency and the measures which are to be taken for their protection; and
- (c) permit the Secretary of State for Defence to limit the extent to which the prior information requirements apply in any particular case where he is of the opinion that this is against the interests of national security.
