ACQUISITION OF LAND (ASSESSMENT OF COMPENSATION) ACT, 1919.

NOTICE is hereby given that in pursuance of the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act, 1919, as amended by Section 1 of the Administrative Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland has, for the purposes of Sections 9 and 13 of the Planning and Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, made rules regarding the questions to be referred to the official arbitrator, and regulating

the procedure before him in dealing with questions respecting property injuriously affected or increased in value and unsightly and dilapidated structures, within the meaning of the Planning and Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1931.

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1920-1931.
