

IMPORTATION OF SEMEN, EMBRYOS AND OVA  
ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1993

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland has made the Importation of Semen, Embryos and Ova Order (Northern Ireland) 1993. This Order prohibits the importation into Northern Ireland from outside the European Communities of the semen, embryos and ova of animals except under and in accordance with the conditions of a licence granted by the Department of Agriculture.

Provision is also made for the revocation, variation and suspension of licences.

The Order comes into operation on 24th January, 1994.
