WILD BIRDS PROTECTION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1931.

In pursuance of Section 16 (6) of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, Notice is Hereby Given that the Minister of Home Affairs, on the advice of the Wild Birds Advisory Committee for Northern Ireland, proposes to make Orders under Section 7 of the Act to the following effect:—

(1) Directing that the provisions of Section 7, prohibiting the sale of birds for human consumption during the close season, shall not apply in respect of any bird specified in Category 3, Part 3 of the First Schedule to the Act during the period of 15 days next after the beginning of the close season for such birds, that is to say, the 1st March in each year.

(2) Directing that the provisions of Section 6, relating to the protection of birds, and Section 7, prohibiting their sale for human consumption during the close season, shall not apply in respect of ptarmigan, hazel grouse, capercaillie, and quail, provided such birds are killed or taken outside Great Britain or the Irish Free State and imported into Northern Ireland.

The purpose of these Orders is to enable poultry dealers, etc., to have in possession and to sell their stock of the birds referred to in Order No. 1 during a period of 15 days after the 1st March in each year, and such foreign birds as are specified in Order No. 2 throughout the year.

Objections to the above proposals must be lodged with the Ministry on or before the 22nd February, 1932.
