

of May, 1928, and five Codicils thereto, devised and bequeathed, on the death of his widow, Mrs. Owens, the following Charitable Legacies:—

To the Superioress of the Convent of Mercy, Crumlin Road, Belfast, the sum of £200 for the benefit of the Hospice for the Dying; and the sum of £200 for the benefit of St. Brigid's Home; and £500 for the benefit of the Mater Infirmorum Hospital, Crumlin Road, Belfast.

To the Rev. James Murphy, of St. Joseph's R.C. Church, Belfast, the sum of £100, to be applied by him for the benefit of St. Joseph's Babies Home, Crumlin Road, Belfast.

To the Superioress of the Sisters of Nazareth the sum of £500, to be applied for the benefit of the Homes supported by them.

To the Rector of Holy Cross, Ardoyne, Belfast, the sum of £200 for Masses, to be said for the benefit of Testator and his wife;

To the Rector of the Redemptorist Fathers, Clonard, Belfast, the sum of £200 for a like purpose.

To the Roman Catholic Orphanage of the Diocese of Down and Connor, Testator's holding of £800 2½ per cent. Consolidated Government Stock, and Bond for £100 in the Belfast Harbour Commissioners, the income only, if possible, to be applied for the orphans.

To the Parish Priest of Sacred Heart Church, Belfast, the sum of £50 for Masses, to be said for the benefit of Testator, his wife, and deceased relatives;

To the Parish Priest of Leitrim, Drumgoolan Upper, £100 for a like purpose;

To the Parish Priest of Dromara the sum of £50 for a like purpose.

To the Society of St. Vincent De Paul Particular Council of Belfast the sum of £500.

To the Administrator of St. Patrick's R.C. Church, Belfast, the sum of £50 for Masses, for the benefit of Testator, his wife, and his deceased relatives.

To the Most Rev. Dr. Mulhern, or other, the Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Dro-

more, and the Parish Priest of Drumgoolan Upper, the sum of £1,000, to be invested in their names and the income therefrom to be applied towards the maintenance and education of a candidate for the Priesthood in the Diocese of Dromore, said legacy to be paid only out of Testator's holding of 3½ per cent. Conversion Loan.

To the Catholic Curate of Leitrim the sum of £50 for Masses for the repose of the soul of Testator and his wife;

To the Catholic Curate of Bellella, Parish of Dromore, the sum of £50 for a like purpose;

To the Catholic Curate of Clanvarahan, Parish of Drumaroad, the sum of £50 for a like purpose.

To his Executors the sum of £70 for the erection of a Window in Memory of Testator in the Catholic Church at Leitrim, County Down.

To the Parish Priest of Leitrim, County Down, the sum of £100, to be invested by him and the income applied towards the upkeep of the Grotto at Lourdes, at Leitrim, County Down.

As to all the Residue of his Estate, Testator bequeathed same to the Roman Catholic Bishop of Dromore and the Parish Priest of Drumgoolan Upper, the income therefrom to be applied towards the maintenance and education of candidates for the Priesthood, preference to be given those whose origin or place of residence is in the Parish of Leitrim.

Probate to the Will and Codicils of said Testator was granted forth of the High Court of Justice in Northern Ireland, King's Bench Division (Probate), the Principal Registry, on the 19th day of July, 1932, to the Executors therein named.
