Under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon the Clearing Office and the Administrator by Article I (XIV) of the Treaty of Peace (Austria) Orders, 1920-1921, I hereby pre-scribe the 30th (thirtieth) day of December, 1922, as the final date by which proofs by British nationals of debts due to them by Austrian nationals, or of pecuniary obligations

of the Austrian Government under Article 248 of the Treaty of Saint Germain-en-Laye and other claims by British nationals against the Austrian Government with the payment of which the property, rights, and interests within His Majesty's Dominions or Protectorates belonging to nationals of the former Austrian Empire at the date when the said Treaty came into force (not being property, rights, or interests acquired under any general license issued by or on behalf of His Majesty), and the net proceeds of their sale, liquidation, or other dealings therewith are charged by Article I (IX) of the above-mentioned Orders in Council must be made upon the prescribed forms and lodged with this Department in order to rank for payment of the first dividend to be declared by me out of the above-mentioned property, rights, and interests belonging to nationals of the former Austrian Empire.
