ALTERING THE PROCLAMATION OF THE 4th OCTOBER 1953 DETERMINING NEW INSCRIPTIONS FOR GOLD, SILVER, CUPRO NICKEL, MIXED METAL AND BRONZE COINS

Whereas under section 3(1)(b) and (h) of the Coinage Act 1971 We have the power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to determine the design of any coin to be made at Our Mint and to alter any Proclamation previously made under the said section:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the 4th day of October 1953 We determined a new design for the gold coins specified in Our said Proclamation, being the five-pound piece, the two-pound piece, the sovereign and the half-sovereign:

And Whereas by Our Proclamation dated the 17th day of April 1985 We altered the paragraph headed "GOLD COINS" of Our said
