
Notice Of Intention To Make A Stopping-up Order Century Street, Belfast

The Department for Regional Development hereby gives notice of its intention to make an order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 the effect of which would be to stop-up to vehicular traffic Century Street in the City of Belfast, at its junction with Crumlin Road, after the completion of such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities.

The road proposed to be stopped-up is delineated on a map which, together with a copy of a draft of the order, may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period from 4th January 2002 to 11th February 2002 at the Department's Roads Services offices, Headquarters, Room 201, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast; and Eastern Division, Hydebank, Hospital Road, Belfast.

Any person may within the said period object to the proposal by written notice to Roads Service Headquarters at the address above stating the grounds of objection.

PUBLIC MEETINGS AND CONSULTATION PROCESS THE PLANNING (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1991

Planning Service, an agency within the Department of the Environment has recently published the Issues Paper for the proposed Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan. The Plan, which will be prepared within the context of the Regional Development Strategy, relates to the administrative areas of Belfast, Carrickfergus, Castlereagh, Lisburn, Newtownabbey and North Down Councils. The purpose of the plan is to provide a framework that will guide and control future development in the area up to the year 2015. The plan will cover a range of issues including housing, transport, education, health and community facilities, natural and built heritage, tourism and the green belt.

The Issues Paper forms the basis for public consultation and seeks to stimulate debate on important planning matters in the plan area. To encourage an inclusive consultation process, a series of information and consultation meetings are planned. The information meetings aim to provide background on the planning process and identify issues which have emerged to date. At the consultation meetings local and plan-wide issues will be discussed in-depth and views sought from the public. The outcome of the consultation will assist in the preparation of the
