MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTH- ERN IRELAND), 1936.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture has made an Order in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 17 of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland) 1936, appointing the 30th day of July, 1936, to be the appointed day for the coming into operation of such provisions of the Act as are necessary for the purpose of the establishment of the Egg Marketing Committee for Northern Ireland.

WHEREAS I, The Right Honourable Sir William Moore, Baronet, Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers given to me by the Supreme Court of Judicature (Ireland) Acts, 1877 to 1897, the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, the General Adaptation of Enactments (Northern Ireland) Order, 1921, and all other powers and authorities enabling me on that behalf, with the concurrence of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, did by Order, dated September 16th, 1926, fix and appoint the fees set out in the Schedule to the said Order as the fees to be taken in the Supreme Court of Judicature of Northern Ireland:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to abolish fees numbered 54 and 267 and to amend items numbered 55, 266 and 279 of the said Schedule:

Now I, the said Right Honourable Sir William Moore, Baronet, Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland, with the concurrence of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, do hereby order that the said fees numbered 54 and 267 be abolished, and that the said items numbered 55, 266 and 279 be amended as set forth in the Schedule hereto.

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1936.

279. Add after the words in brackets the words "excepting any dividend, annuity or other periodical payment not exceeding £100."
