ROAD RESTRICTIONS

DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE WAITING RESTRICTIONS – PORTSTEWART

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Waiting Restrictions (Portstewart) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017", (S.R. 2017 No. 238), which comes into operation on 22 January 2018. The rule will prohibit vehicles waiting at any time (loading and unloading permitted) on lengths of Strand Road, Portstewart. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances. The rule will also revoke and re-enact existing waiting restrictions in Portstewart.

DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DERRYCARNE ROAD, PORTADOWN

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled The C161 Derrycarne Road, Portadown, (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 (S.R. 2017 No. 237) which will come into operation on 6 February 2018.

The Order will abandon 694.5 square metres of road comprising road embankment adjacent to No. 89 Derrycarne Road, Portadown.

DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE SPEED LIMITS

The Department for Infrastructure has made a Statutory Rule entitled "The Roads (Speed Limit (No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017", (S.R. 2017 No. 236), which comes into operation on 22nd January 2018.

The rule will apply 30 and 40 miles per hour speed limits on lengths of road in Ardglass, Castlewellsan, Dungannon, Moneyglass, Newcastle, Newtownards and Portadown.

DEPARTMENT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE ABANDONMENT – LIMAVADY ROAD, GARVAGH

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) being of the opinion that the road is not necessary for road traffic, proposes to make an Order to abandon 370 square metres of road outside 19-21 Limavady Road, Garvagh, after the completion of such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic.
